With 5 seconds notice we find ourselves in Ireland, for a nice mid-season friendly. First division Bray Wanderers are a part-time side. The best bits:

- 5' a bright start, Jeffers took the ball into the box, just the keeper to beat, put it straight at him.
- 9' Bray's keeper again to the rescue, this time Carsley from in side the area forcing the save.
- 20' McFadden from 25 yards out, shot on target, but did not trouble the keeper.
- 24' 0-1 Jeffers with the break though, deep cross via McFadden, at the back post, Jeffers waiting unmarked to side foot home.
- 45' 0-2 Jeffers Carsley this time the provider of the cross, in from the left, Jeffers took his time from well inside the 18 yard area, hit it hard and low.

Half time: Bray Wanderers 0 - 2 Everton

- 45' On: Watson & Radzinski; off: Unsworth & Campbell
- 57' Steve Watson from the right finds Radzinski, he shoots first time, just past the far post.
- 72' On: Chadwick; off: Jeffers
- 76' 0-3 McFadden picks up the ball from midfield, runs at the defence, holds off 3 or 4 defenders, finds himself in the box, sees a gap, fires in low in at the bottom corner (best goal of the night)
- 80' we have two chances in 60 seconds: Watson with another good ball this time from midfield, Radzinski again hits it first time, only to see it slip past the near post; then Scott Gemmill with a cross from the right, Chadwick had a free header but it floats over the upright.
- 84' another Chadwick free header, this time from six-yards out, even closer than the first miss.
- 87' 0-4 Chadwick McFadden crosses in from the left, finds Watson on the right, he lays the ball into the path of Chadwick, this time from close range could not fail to miss.


